WHAT TO SEE THE CASTLE

Situated at the entrance to the harbour lies Grainne Uaile's (Grace O'Malley's) castle, stronghold of Clare Island's pirate queen.

THE ABBEY

13th century Cistercian Abbey with some of the best preserved medieval wall paintings in Ireland. Reputed resting place of Grainne Uaile.

CLARE ISLAND LIGHTHOUSE

For almost two centuries, the island's Lighthouse has been a nautical landmark perched high on the craggy cliffs, watching over Achill, Westport and beyond. This architecturally majestic, listed building has been lovingly transformed into fully catered, luxury accommodation. It is not open to the public.

THE NAPOLEONIC SIGNAL TOWER

Built in the early 1800s, as part of a communication system to warn against a French invasion. Only the ruin remains.

ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES

Among the archaeological sites are fulachta fia and a megalithic court tomb.

HILLWALKING

Spectacular cliffs and seabird colonies afford a fantastic setting for exploring the island.
